LATEST NEWS

NEW ROAD NAMES AND SIGNAGE AT PROTOS

As part of the new infrastructure for phase 2 at Protos we've delivered 1.6km of new roads (alongside new nature areas, bridges, ditches and services). The new roads all needed a name so we chose some that are inspired by what happens at Protos. The assigned names and postcodes are as follows:

- Innovation Way CH2 4AA
- **Conversion Drive CH2 4FL**
- Generation Road CH2 4FJ
- **Kinetic Street CH2 4FN**

We've also been speaking to Cheshire West & Chester Council about updating the signage to Protos to help prevent HGVs getting lost and going through local villages. New signage has been installed to provide clearer wayfinding.

ENERGY RECOVERY FACILITY (ENCYCLIS)

Construction of the Energy Recovery Facility (ERF) at Protos is continuing. The remaining structural erection works are progressing including installation of cladding to the exterior of the buildings. The hydraulic pressure test of the second boiler was successfully completed at the end of 2023. The majority of the main equipment is now in place within the facility, with extensive cabling and pipework installation works now underway. Around 550 people are working on site each day to complete the construction works over the coming months. Preparation for the commissioning phase has also begun.

JOB VACANCIES AT ENCYCLIS

The recruitment of operational and maintenance staff for the facility is in progress. A number of new colleagues have recently joined the team and the next phase of recruitment is coming soon. NATURE AREAS UPDATE

Over 50 hectares of land is being dedicated to nature at Protos where over 2,600 trees have already been planted. Snipe Haven and Goldfinch Meadows are two purposebuilt habitats which are home to an array of flowers, butterflies and birds.

The Cheshire Wildlife Trust (CWT) continue to manage the nature areas at Protos. In the last few months, they have seen a myriad of birds across Goldfinch Meadows, Snipe Haven and further afield, including barn owl, marsh harrier, pied flycatcher, yellow wagtail, swifts and skylarks. Signs of breeding have also been observed for a number of bird species, such as little ringed plover nesting within vegetation around a pond, alongside a number of ducklings spotted feeding along the ditches and ponds. There's also been evidence of water vole recorded along the ditches, with badger signs seen across the nature areas. Foraging activity for common pipistrelle, soprano pipistrelle and noctule have also been observed.

PROTOS AS CARBON CAPTURE READY DESTINATION

Carbon capture involves capturing carbon dioxide (CO₂) prior to its release into the atmosphere and safely storing it underground, utilising existing voids created by oil and gas extraction.

In the North West, leading hydrogen and carbon capture project HyNet has been identified by Government as one of the first two carbon capture clusters in the UK. Operator ENI was recently granted development consent for the HyNet Carbon Dioxide Pipeline – a new pipeline to transport CO_2 from both upcoming hydrogen production sites and current industrial facilities in the region and storage in almostempty gas fields under the sea in Liverpool Bay.

Having developed plans for a local CO₂ pipeline we are working with ENI to establish Protos as one of the first carbon-capture ready destinations in the UK. A planning application was submitted by ENI in March 2024 for the Protos Carbon Dioxide Spur Pipeline, which will spur from the HyNet CO_2 pipeline and serve the various developments at Protos.

This will include the Protos Energy Recovery Facility currently under construction. Encyclis is developing plans for a new Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) facility and recently signed a Statement of Principles with the UK Government, formalising the commercial basis for the development of the plant so that final negotiations can commence.

Other users will include Evero's Ince Bio Power site, a waste wood to energy facility located at Protos. The site will have a direct line to HyNet to kick start their InBECCS project, which would capture as much as 250,000 tonnes of CO_2 a year, once operational in 2029.

NEW BIKE SHELTERS FOR HELSBY HIGH SCHOOL

Pupils at Helsby High School are finding it easier to cycle to school with new bike shelters installed with help from the Protos Community Benefit Fund. Jointly funded by the school's Parent Teacher Association (PTA), Cheshire West & Chester Council (CWAC) and Protos, the two new bike shelters have already proved a hit with avid cyclists.

This sustainable initiative not only helps to reduce traffic and improve air quality but it also fosters positive health benefits for students and a sense of accomplishment and independence not taught in the classroom.



ELTON COMMUNITY CENTRE GETS NEW GREEN LOOS



The Elton Community Centre offers a range of services and activities for the local community from exercise classes to toddler groups and bingo. There has been lots of work to improve the centre over the last two years but the toilets were in dire need of an upgrade and so the Protos Community Fund stepped in to help fund the refurbishment.

Their shiny new bathrooms not only are more accessible, but access activated heating/lighting, new hand driers and reduced water usage have made them more environmentally friendly.
